To run approximately 3350' of 1 1/4" EUE tubing and to complete and produce as a Pictured Cliffs gas producer. To comply with the rules and regulations of the U. S. and New Mexico Oil and Gas Commission.

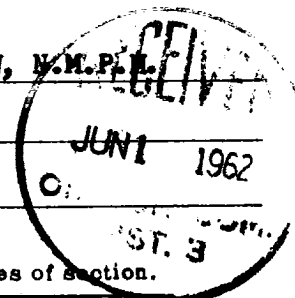

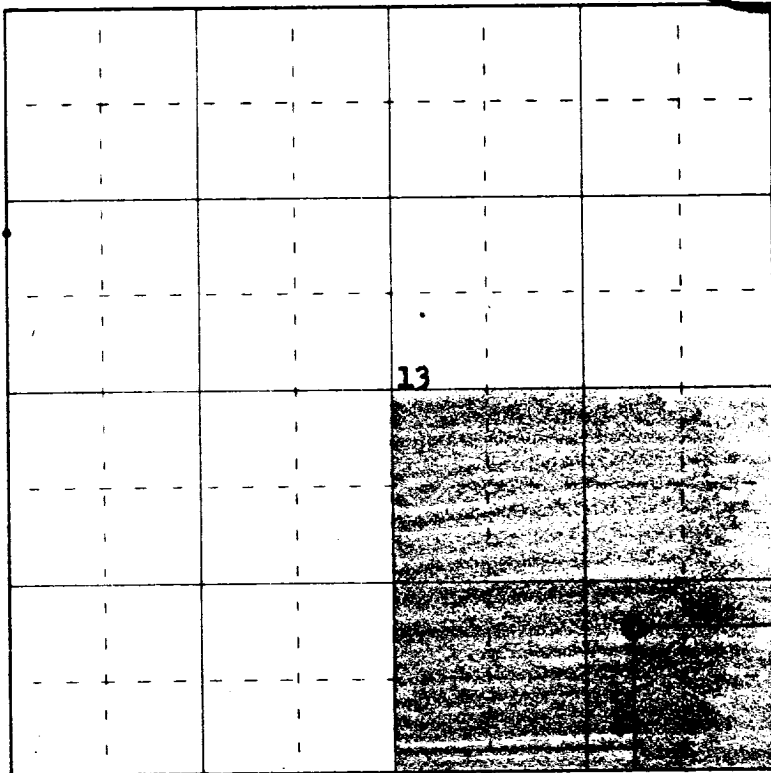
