Dear Mr. Prentice:

We have not yet received a reply to our letter dated August 3, 1976, concerning the possibilities of your company purchasing gas from the above well.

For your information, we have recently completed the Gallup formation in this well and it appears that it is going to produce at a rate of about 200 MCF per day. This added to our estimates of 300 MCF per day for the Greenhorn-Dakota formation, will make our combined delivery about 500 MCF per day assuming the oil commission allows us to commingle the two zones.

We look forward to your reply as to whether your company is interested in buying this gas, and if you are, the terms your company would include in the contract.
