Dear Mr. Sims:

The captioned well is currently authorized to vent casinghead gas until July 18, 1983. The Gallo White #1 is being produced 45 minutes per day on a time cycle controller and averages approximately 4.8 BOPD and 36 MCFD.

We have recently completed extensive negotiations with Northwest Pipeline and have executed a gas contract . We are currently in the process of negotiating with Northwest Pipeline to install a gathering system in the field. Dugan Production may have to install the necessary gathering system to deliver gas into Northwest Pipeline's system, and have applied for, and received a Rightof-Way to do so, however, we are discussing the possiblilty of Northwest Pipeline installing the system, in view of the fact that several other operators also have wells in this general area. We hope to have matters resolved as to who will install the gathering system in the very near future, and upon doing so, would anticipate being able to complete the installation within 2 - 3 weeks.

As previously mentioned, Dugan Production has secured the necessary Right-of-Ways. In view of the July 18, 1983 expiration of authorization to vent gas, and our current efforts to install a gathering system, we request permission to vent gas from the Gallo Red #1 for an additional 3 month period. Should this request not be granted, it will be necessary for us to shut the well in on July 18.
