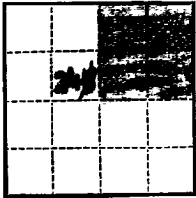

DETAILS OF WORK

Subject well spudded June 18, 1962. Set 102' of 8 5/8" surface casing and cemented with 60 sacks. Total depth of 3105' reached June 21, 1962. Set 4 1/2" casing at 3070' and cemented with 125 sacks. Subject well was perforated at the intervals of 2960'-2968'; 2976'-2988', and sand fraced July 1, 1962 with 30,000# sand and 35,000 gallons water.

Well presently awaiting testing.
