Amoco Production Company proposes to drill four Ballard Pictured Cliffs Field development wells on Jicarilla Apache land at the following locations:

✓ Jicarilla Tribal 358 No. 3 - 1190' FWL & 1790' FNL of
Section 6, T-22-N, R-2-W, Sandoval County, New Mexico.

Jicarilla Tribal 358 No. 4 - 1550' FEL & 1600' FSL of
Section 6, T-22-N, R-2-W, Sandoval County, New Mexico.

Jicarilla Tribal 358 No. 5 - 790' FNL & 1190' FEL of
Section 7, T-22-N, R-2-W, Sandoval County, New Mexico.

Jicarilla Tribal 390 No. 3 - 800' FNL & 850' FEL of
Section 24, T-23-N, R-4-W, Sandoval County, New Mexico

The proposed locations are all located near previous drilling sites. Consequently only a total of 1.2 miles of new road will be necessary to construct and 2.2 miles of improvement on existing roads. Roads will be cleared with minimum damage to any existing trees. Before any pine trees are disturbed it will be cleared with the Jicarilla Apache Tribe.

Arrangements are being made for trucking water to the location for drilling needs. Upon completion of each well the location will be cleaned, leveled and the reserve pits backfilled.

The attached development plans show in detail the location of the proposed well sites in relation to other existing roads and locations. There are
