The following is an "Application for Suspension of Production" for the last producing well on a federal jurisdictional lease.

1. The Navajo 14C lease is in its extended term.
2. The Navajo 14C No. 1 is the only well on the lease and is currently producing.
3. The Navajo 14C No. 1 is a stripper well in that it generates a very small margin of profit. Exceedingly high operating costs are incurred in lifting and disposing of the large volume of water associated with the oil production.
4. The Navajo 14C No. 1 produces 50 BOPD and 8000 BWPD and is therefore capable of production in paying quantities. Failure to suspend production could lead to premature abandonment.

Approval of this Sundry Notice does not imply approval by the BIA. Before approval of suspension of production can be granted, consent of the mineral owners must be obtained and BIA concurrence will be required.
