Drill 265' 13½ surface hole, set 250' 8-5/8" csg. Cement to surface with 225 sxs. Using oil base mud (15%) oil and adequate BOP drill a 7-7/8" hole to 7500' to test the Dakota formation. If productive, run 4½" 10.5# or heavier casing to total depth and cement in stages to cover the producing zones including the Pictured Cliffs formation. If non-productive, plug and abandon. The BOP to be a Schaeffer double gate hydraulic tested to 5000#. Coleman Drilling Company to be the contractor.

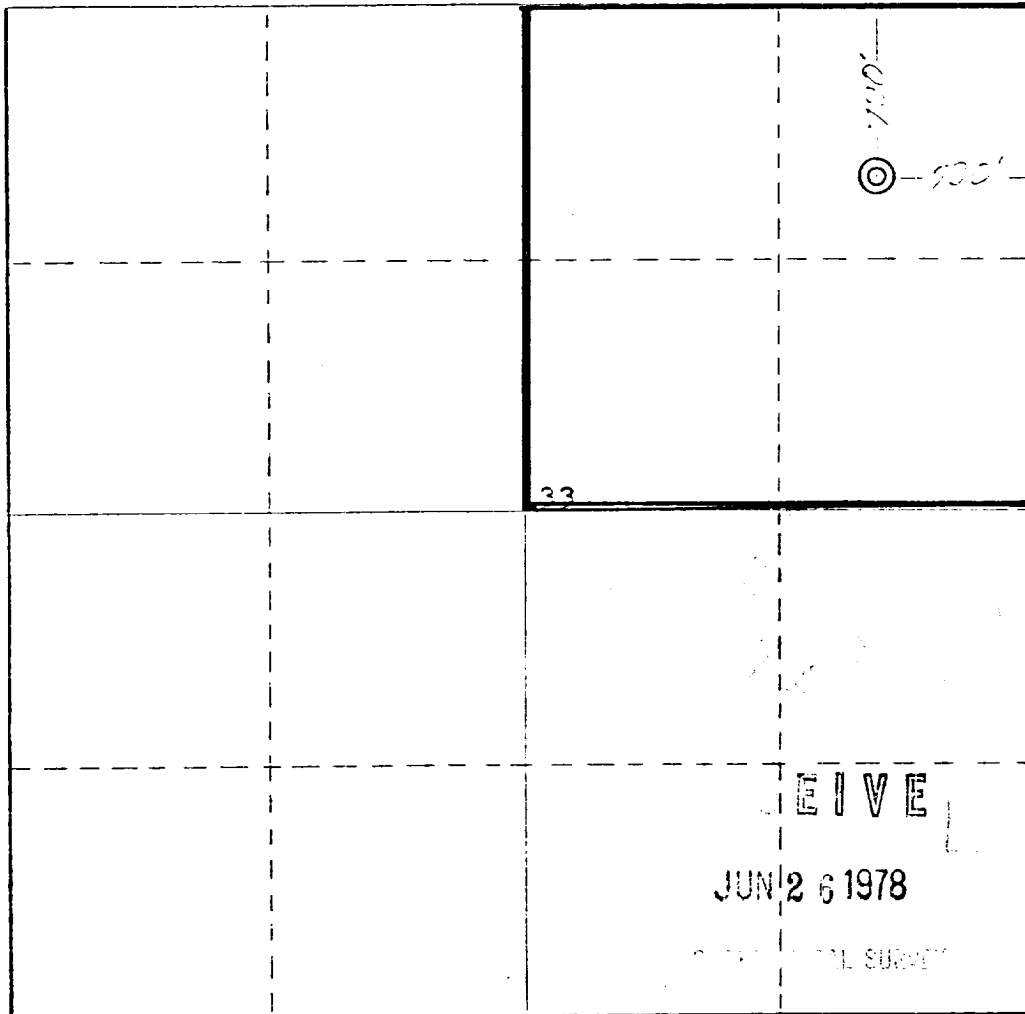
