Dear Mr. Keller:

This is in reply to your letter of May 10, the requirements of which were extended to July 17, 1991.

The subject wells are currently shut-in gas wells. They were tested late last year, #10 shown to be a good Chacra producer and #5 and 11 being marginal. We are attempting to get a line into the area and hook up #10. If this well held up as indicated, #5 and #11 would be worked over inasmuch as their initial testing results and log characteristics were similar.

Our efforts to produce these wells are running into the current poor gas market and the obstacle of Indian rights-of-way. Nevertheless, we are actively pursuing this matter as we do not want to prematurely abandon a potentially valuable property.
