- 11-14-92     Move in rig up Aztec #184. Spud surface hole at 9:00 p.m., 11-14-92. TD surface hole @ 150 ft. @ 11:30 p.m., 11-14-92. Run 3 jts (130 ft.) 8 5/8" J-55 ST&C new casing. Land casing at 145 ft. RKB. Rig up Cementers Inc. and cement with 100 sx Clas B w/2% CaCl. Circulate 6 bbls good cement to pit. Plug down @ 1:10 a.m., 11-15-92. WOC and nipple up BOP.
- 11-15-92     Pressure test casing, held OK. Drill cement, drill out into open hole. Drilling at 1750 ft.
