On February 20, 1997, I inspected the referenced well site. Although it has been over one year since the well was plugged, the site has not yet been cleaned-up satisfactorily as follows:

1. There has been no effort to cover the drilling pits and remove the exposed pit lining material.
2. The rig anchors are still in place.
3. The mouse hole and rat hole are open and pose a hazard to livestock and people.
4. The required abandonment marker for the #1 well has not been set.

You are hereby directed to commence cleanup activities within 30 days or face possible fines. Contact this office before starting so that we may provide a witness.

7 " casing @ 6916' KB w/200 sx. Plugged back with 260 sacks.

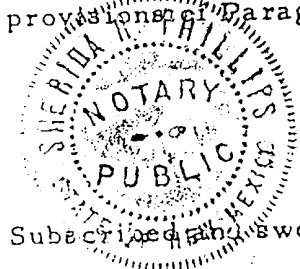

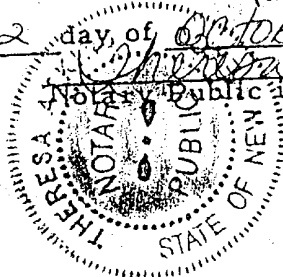
