The Chaco Unit No. 4 was spudded at 4:30 P. M. May 27, 1957.

154.80' - 8-5/8" 21# 8 rnd. thd. J-55 casing was set at 167.45' with 125 sacks of cement May 28, 1957. P. D. at 5:30 A. M. Cement circulated.

After 2 1/2 hours the casing was pressured with 500 psi for 30 minutes. The test was satisfactory, so drilling was resumed with a 7-7/8" bit.
