Dear Mr. Owensby:

New Mexico Oil Conservation Order R-8952 (for the protection of migratory birds) became effective June 15, 1989 and states that <u>all pits</u> and open top tanks more than 16' in diameter shall be screened, netted or covered.

Field inspections conducted by Jackie Neckels from the BLM on May 27, 1993 revealed that the above mentioned pits contained hydrocarbons and require compliance. In order for these pits to be in compliance, you are hereby directed to remove all fluid and properly net these pits by August 20, 1993.
