# ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

# BY THE CONNISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on February 25, 1960, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Slvis A. Utz, Examiner duly appointed by the Gil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this Sinday of March, 1960, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Exeminer, Sivis A. Uts, and being fully advised in the premises,

# FIELDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant is the owner and operator of the Sperling Well Ho. 1-30, located in the ME/4 SE/4 of Section 30, Township 24 North, Range 6 West, MARK, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the abovedescribed Sperling Well No. 1-30 in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from an undesignated Gallup pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota pool through parallel strings of 2-3/8 inch OD tubing.
- (4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and in accord with good conservation practices.
- (5) That approval of the subject application will neither cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Val R. Rease & Associates, Inc., he and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Sparling Well Ho. 1-30, located in the HE/4 SE/4 of Section 30, Township 24 Morth, Range & West, MMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the preduction of oil from an undesignated Gallup pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota pool through parallel strings of 2-3/8 inch OD tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER. That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take pecker-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Dakota Producing Interval.

#### IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.
