In the event the Gallup is dry the hole may be deepened to the LaBota sand at 6500'.

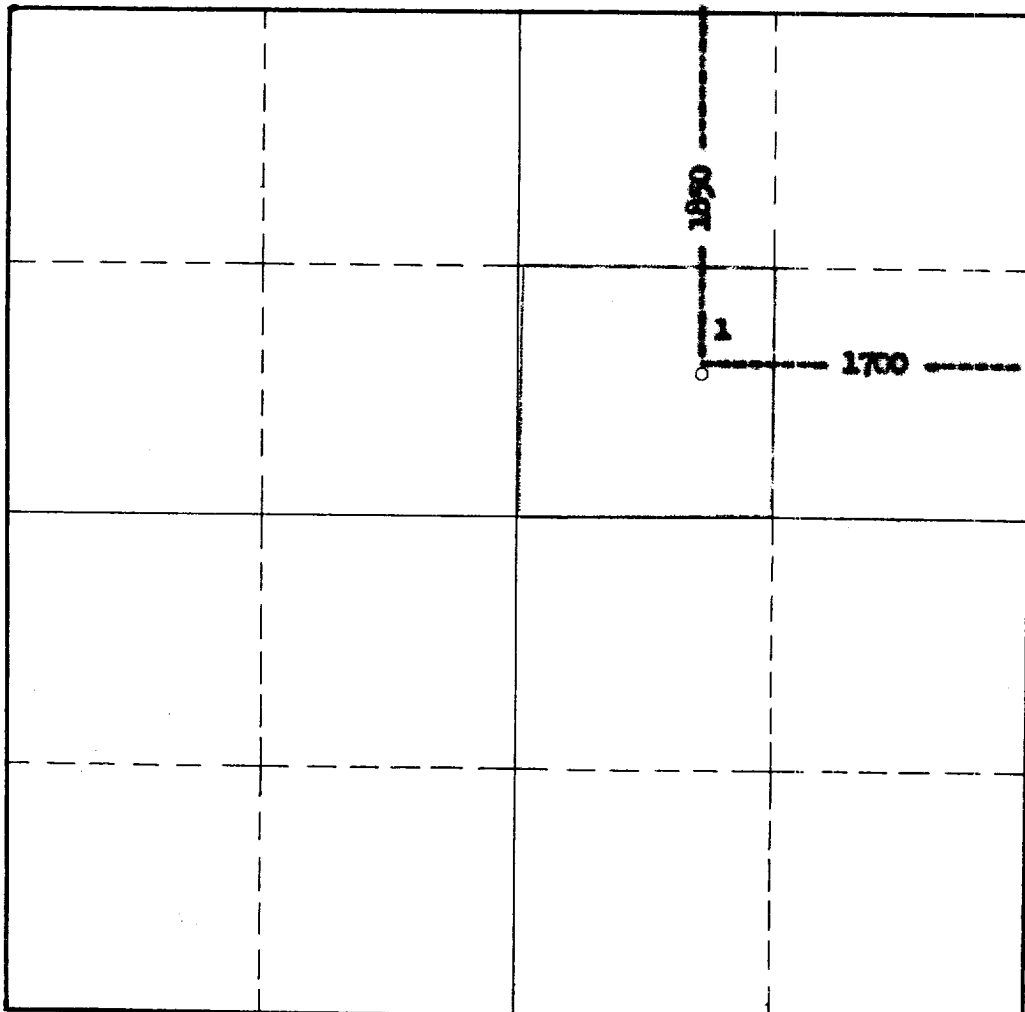
