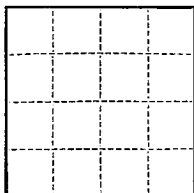

DETAILS OF WORK

This well was drilled to a TD 7251'. After running Schlumberger Electric Log and Sonic log to 7251', it was decided that dual completing in Pictured Cliffs or Lewis and Dakota formation would not be of commercial value. It was decided to complete this well in the Dakota formation only. Our change in casing program is as follows.

7250' Casing 5-1/2" OD DS J-55 L18C Combination 15 1/2 and 17 1/2, Cemented with 1100 sacks cement, 2-stage.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
