May 3rd. Ran Schlumberger To Total Depth 3616'. Top Of Pictured Cliffs Sand @ 3490' Ran 5558' Of 5 1/2" - 14 lb. - 555 Casing. Cemented With 50 Sacks Of Regular Cement, 50 Sacks Of Pozmix, With 4% Gel. Plug Down @ 11:45 AM. Set Plug With 1000 lbs. Pressure And Held For 45 Min.
