Dear Sir:

We have received 2 copies of Notice of Intention to Drill on your Federal "H" well located 1962 feet from the South Line and 1916 feet from the East Line of Section 30-25N-1W.

As you know, our spacing rules require that a well be located at least 790 feet from the boundary lines of the quarter section upon which it is located. This well is therefore a non-standard location and in the event production is encountered, Form C-110 cannot be approved until you have secured administrative approval for the non-standard location.

This approval is requested from Mr. A. L. Porter Jr., Box 871, Santa Fe, New Mexico and can be granted only in the event that the non-standard location was caused by rough topography. In the event your location was not made as it was for this reason then it would be necessary to make application for a hearing in order to secure approval of the location. If the location is non-standard by reason of rough terrain and you wish to secure administrative approval it will also be necessary that you secure waivers from all offset operators before approval can be granted.
