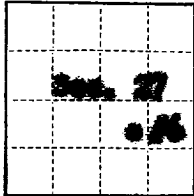

It is our intention to drill well No. 6 to approximately 7300' to test the Dakota Sand formation. Our casing program is as follows:

400' of 10-3/4" OD 31.7% casing - cemented with 600 lbs. reg. cement - simulated.
7300' of 5-1/2" OD 14' casing - cemented with 600 lbs. reg. cement.

The designated drilling unit is the SE 1/4 of Section 27-27-24

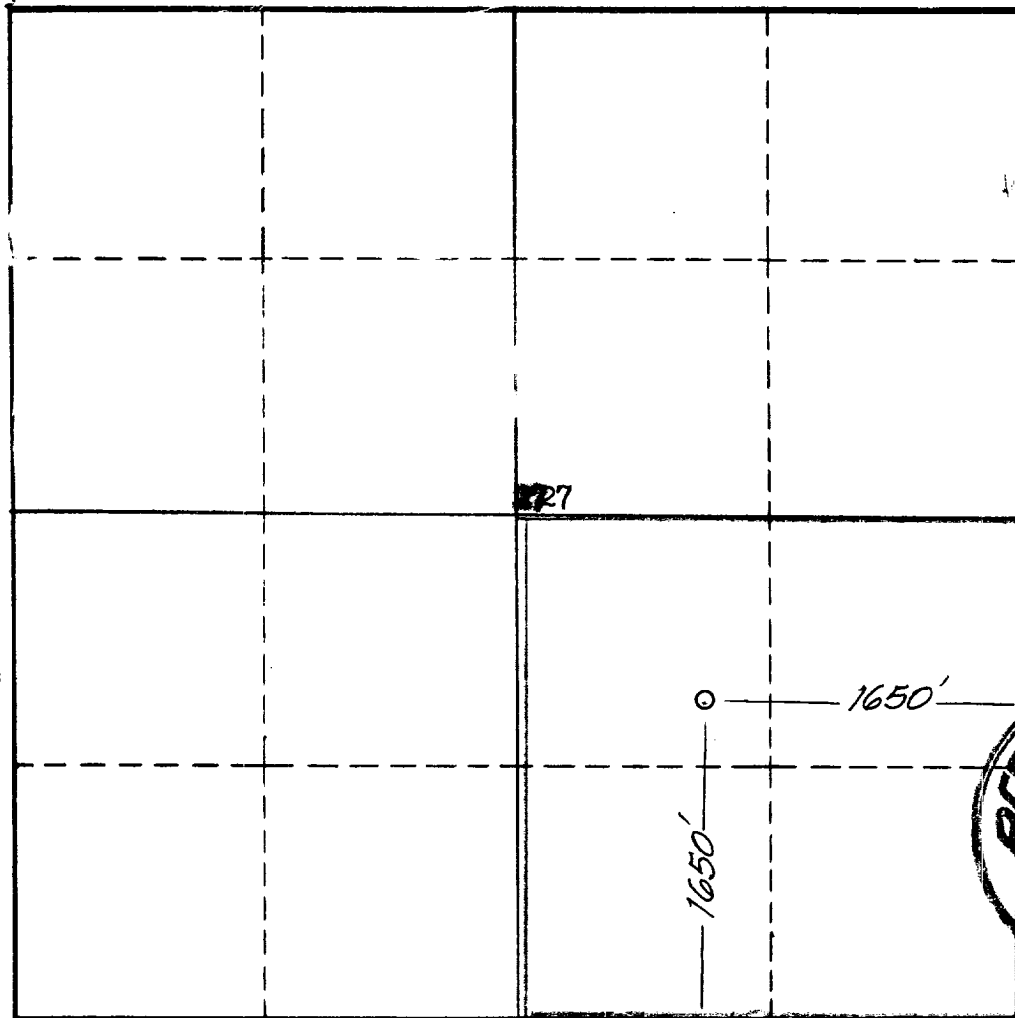

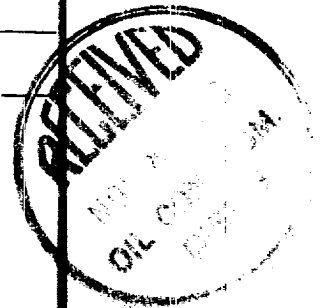
