- 1. That the applicant is the operator of this lease which contains 2560 acres and is described as the S/2 Section 21 and S/2 Section 22; all of Section 27 and 28; N/2 Section 33 and N/2 of Section 34, all in Township 25 North and Range 5 West, Rio Arriba County.
- 2. That the applicant's Jicarilla "C" Well No. 9 is located 1450° from the South and West lines of Section 28-25N-5W. Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.
  - 3. That the applicant dually completed the well in the following
  - a. Perforated 5-1/2" casing from 2620° to 2654° in the Pictured Cliffs.
    - b. Perforated 5-1/2" casing from 3470 to 3512 in the

- 6. That a diagramatic sketch showing the producing intervals and the physical equipment used in dualling the well is attached.
- 7. That a plat showing the above described lands and all offset properties, indicating well locations and lease ownership to the best of our knowledge is attached.


