

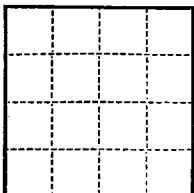

DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well thru the Pictured Cliffs formation using rotary tools to the casing point and to drill the pay section with cable tools and to water fracture the entire pay section. T.D. 3360'.

9 5/8" at 120' with 125 sacks regular cement circulated to surface.  
5 1/8" at 3001' with 75 sacks regular cement and 75 sacks mud.

The NE 1/4 of Section 30 is dedicated to this well.
