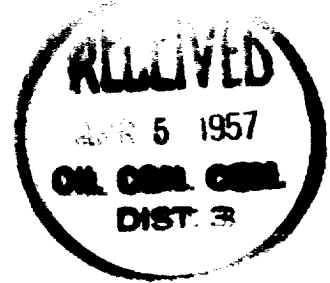

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Gardner-Federal Well No. 30-G Federal to be located 1160 feet from the North line and 480 feet from the West line and in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 30, Township 25 North, Range 1 West, Gavilan Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NW/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as you are the only affected offset operator, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 104 (b) of the General Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission as amended by Order R-855, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 104 (f) of the Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey.

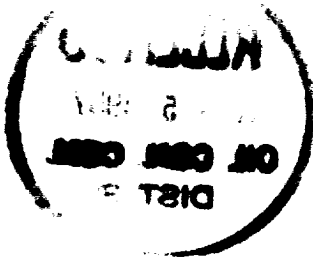

Reference is made to your letter of April 1, 1954, regarding the proposed location for a new gas storage facility. The proposed location is located on the north side of the Santa Fe River, about 10 miles north of the city of Santa Fe, New Mexico.

It is a regrettable fact that the proposed location is not within the boundaries of the Santa Fe River.

Inspection as well as the only licensed operator of a gas storage facility approved to be permitted. Therefore, by a majority vote of the Board of Directors of the Santa Fe Gas Company, the Board of Directors of the Santa Fe Gas Company has decided to grant an exception to Rule 104 (b) of the General Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission as amended by Order No. 555. You are hereby granted an exception to Rule 104 (b) of the General Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission for the above described location for gas storage. Also, state the approval from the Oil Conservation Commission.
