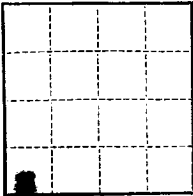

DETAILS OF WORK

Completed as a pumping well in the First & Second Gallup sands in March, 1959. T.S. 7020', P.S. 6005'. Perforated 6860' to 6915' & 6932' to 6980'. We propose to deepen this well through the Third & Fourth Gallup zones to an estimated depth of 7235' and run and cement 230' of 4" flush joint liner to T.S. It is planned to perforate and sand-oil squeeze the Third and Fourth Gallup intervals. If these intervals are oil-productive, the well will be returned to production.
