Dear Mr. Cospers:

Reference is made to your letter of December 26, 1956 applying for tentative approval for a dual completion on your #10-C Jicarilla well located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22-25N-5W and to the application for Administrative Approval to dually complete the same well filed by your Tulsa office. We are sending a copy of this letter to Mr. Porter, director of the Commission, recommending that the dual completion be approved; however we note that in the application filed by your Tulsa office they neglected to show that a side door choke was to be installed above the production packer. It was my understanding from your letter and from my conversation with you that this side door choke was installed.

We also note that you refer to the sand reservoir in the Lewis as the "Lewis Sands". At the present time the Amerada Petroleum Company is referring to this reservoir in the immediate area of your well as the "La Ventana Sandstone". It has also been referred to by El Paso Natural Gas Company and others as the "Chacra Sandstone". It is hoped that nomenclature for this formation will be resolved in the near future, but until it is resolved we prefer to refer to it as the "Chacra Sandstone".
