

Reference is made to your application of November 27, 1989 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your existing Canyon Largo Unit Well No. 41 located 990 feet from the South line and East lines (Unit P) of Section 24, Township 25 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, which is presently completed at a standard gas well location in the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool. 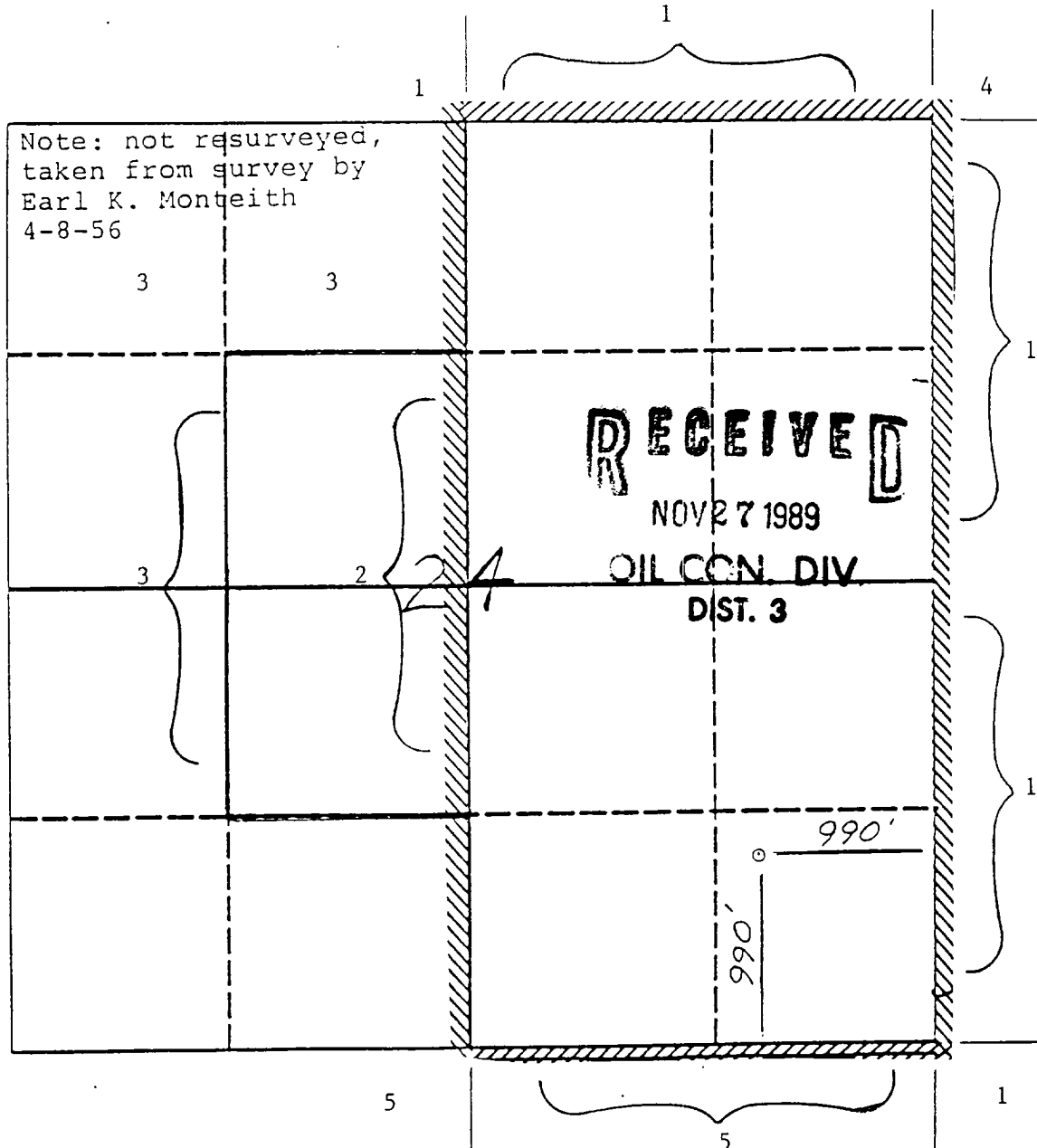
