ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) Kay Kimbell made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on January 19, 1959, for permission to dually complete its Salazar-Federal Well No. 1-22, located in the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 22, Township 25 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Chacra formation and the production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool.

Now on this 24th day of February, 1959, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Kay Kimbell, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Salazar-Federal Well No. 1-22, located in the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 22, Township 25 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Chacra formation and the production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool, through the tubing and the casing-tubing annulus respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A, as amended by Order R-1214.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool.

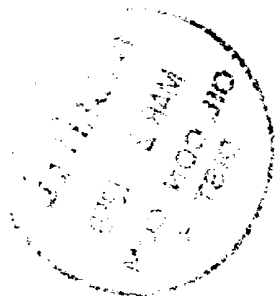
