Dear Sir:

We intend to dual complete our Jicarilla Apache "F" No. 4 located 1650' FSL and 1450' FEL Section 18, T-25-N, R-5-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in the Picture Cliff and La Ventana (Chacra) formations in the following manner.

Perforate LaVentana (Chacra) formation from 3584' to 3610' and perforate Picture Cliff from approximately 2738' - 2754' and 2782' 2795'. Sand-Water frac each zone with 30,000 gallons water and 30,000# sand. A type D production packer will be set at approximately 3500' with a PSI Nipple and separation sleeve at approximately 3490'.
