

THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS JICARILLA WELL NO. 4-C, LOCATED 1660 FEET FROM THE NORTH LINE AND 1600 FEET FROM THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 25 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, NMPM, RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM AN UNDESIGNATED MESAVERDE POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE PICTURED CLIFFS FORMATION ADJACENT TO THE SOUTH BLANCO PICTURED CLIFFS POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on October 14, 1958, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla Well No. 4-C, located 1660 feet from the North line and 1600 feet from the East line of Section 16, Township 25 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool.

Now on this 10th day of November, 1958, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla Well No. 4-C, located 1660 feet from the North line and 1600 feet from the East line of Section 16, Township 25 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Mesaverde pool and the production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool, through the tubing and the casing-tubing annulus respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A, as amended by Order R-1214.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco Mesaverde Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that jurisdiction of this cause is hereby

Under the provisions of Rule 115-1 (a) 11 Cases (Federal and Foreign) under application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on July 1, 1958, for permission to timely complete its title No. 4-C, located 1800 feet from the North line and 1500 feet from the West line of Section 1, Township 10 North, Range 4 West, Meridian 10, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, to allow the production of gas from the Fictured Cliff formation adjacent to the South line of Fictured Cliff Pool.
