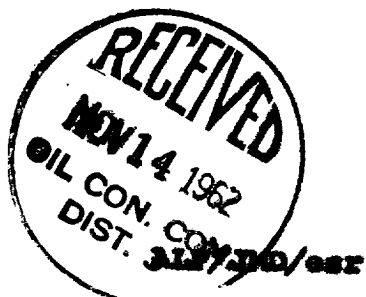
Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Bolack Well No. A-14, located 1125 feet from the North line and 450 feet from the East line of Section 14, Township 25 North, Range 1 West, Basin-Dakota Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. A-1670-C governing the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool, you are hereby granted an exception for the above-described unorthodox well location.

If this well is completed as an oil well, under the provisions of Order No. A-1670-C, it cannot be produced until an unorthodox oil well location has been approved by the Commission after notice and hearing. If this well is completed as a gas well, under the provisions of Order No. A-1670-C, it cannot be produced until 320 acres is dedicated to the well or a non-standard gas proration unit approved by the Commission.

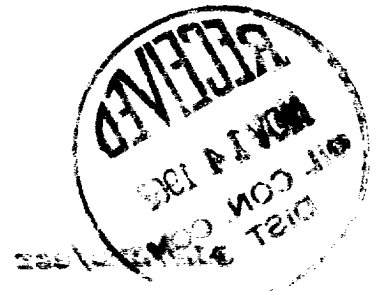
Reference is made to your application for approval of a well location for your oil and gas lease, located 1125 feet from the North line and 450 feet from the East line of Section 16, Township 22 North, Range 1 West, Basin-Dehoda Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Article 1-1870-1 governing the Basin-Dehoda Gas Pool, I am hereby granting an exception for the above-described location for a well location.

If this well is completed as an oil well, under the provisions of Order No. R-1870-1, it cannot be produced until an authorized oil well location has been approved by the Department after notice and hearing. If this well is completed as a gas well, under the provisions of Order No. R-1870-1, it cannot be produced until 320 acres is dedicated to the well or a standard gas production unit approved by the Commission.
