Pictured Cliffs perfs 3613'-17', 3642'-46', 3649'-59' fraced with 50,000# sand, 46,350 gals. water & 200# "ADOMITE AQUA" additive. Landed 2 3/8" tubing at 3626'. Completed 8/17/65 from above perfs. Flowed 1 hour on 3/4" choke; gauged 3393 MCFD, FCP 280#. Shut-in awaiting pipeline connection. Southern Union Gas will be the purchaser.

Instructions

Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
