We respectfully request an exception to Rule 502 on the above described well, pertaining to excessive daily oil production rates. The Operator has scheduled sonolog surveys to determine fluid levels versus daily production rates. Such engineering data is necessary for evaluation of the reservoir, and is especially useful at this time since recent completion of static bottom hole pressure surveys.

Excessive production rates as pertaining to Rule 502 are requested only during the month of July, 1964, until the allowable for the month has been produced.

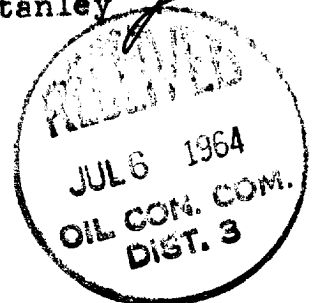
