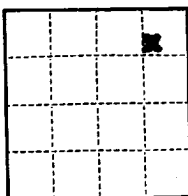

DETAILS OF WORK

- 7/18/57: Pulled 3" tubing. Set Baker OJ wire line retainer at 7900'.
- 7/19/57: Ran 2" tubing and squeezed perforations from 7962' to 7986' w/100 sacks neat cement. Reversed out 20 sacks. Max. & final pr. 4200#. Pulled tubing.
- 7/20/57: Perforated from 5884' - 5904', 5922' - 5934', 5974' - 6030', 6046' - 6108' w/4 bullet shots per foot. Aquafaced with 84,000 gals. water & 100,000# sand. Ave. inj. rate 54.9 bbls./min. at 2900#. Set 2" tubing at 5850'.
