ORDER NO. MC-1636

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Continental Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 1, 1965, for permission to dually complete its AXI Apache "J" Well No. 11, located 990 feet from the North line and 1190 feet from the East line of Section 6, Township 25 North, Range 5 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, to produce gas from the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Otero Chacra Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and 2-inch tubing respectively.

Now, on this 15th day of June, 1965, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its AXI Apache "J" Well No. 11, located 990 feet from the North line and 1190 feet from the East line of Section 6, Township 25 North, Range 5 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, to produce gas from the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Otero Chacra Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and 2-inch tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Otero Chacra Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Article 111-A, Conservation Oil
Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation
Commission on June 1, 1965, for permission to drill, complete and
produce a well No. 11, located 900 feet from the North line and
1100 feet from the East line of Section 6, Township 13 North,
Range 3 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, to produce gas from
the South Flank of the Oilfield and from the Otero Chert
pool through the casing-lining annulus and 2-inch tubing respect-
ively.

Now, on this 10th day of June, 1965, the Commission
has considered:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the
provisions of Article 111-A of the Constitution and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided
that all operations of oil and gas have been duly recorded and
that no operations have been received within the
area of which is prescribed by said rules;
- (3) That the proposed well completion will not cause
waste nor impair conservation rights;
- (4) That the location of the proposed well completion
is suitable and consistent with good conservation practices.

IT IS ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Conservation Oil Company, do
and the same is hereby authorized to drill, complete and
produce a well No. 11, located 900 feet from the North line and
1100 feet from the East line of Section 6, Township 13 North,
Range 3 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, to produce gas from
the South Flank of the Oilfield and from the Otero Chert
pool through the casing-lining annulus and 2-inch tubing respect-
ively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall complete, operate,
and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Article
111-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall take proper
leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the
annual wellhead safety test period for the Otero pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this case
is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the
Commission may deem necessary.

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year here-
