A field inspection of the above location was made by me on November 25, 1968. There was no surface indication that the well has been plugged. A five gallon water can had been placed over the surface casing and no surface plug had been placed as indicated by form C-103 which was filed October 30, 1968. The rat hole on the location was also open and is a hazard to livestock in its present condition. The mud pit had been filled but the location was not leveled.

Your bond cannot be cancelled until the well has been plugged and the location leveled in accordance with Commission regulations.

I am enclosing a form for you to return to this office when the well is ready for inspection.
