

THE APPLICATION OF SOUTHERN UNION
PRODUCTION COMPANY FOR A DUAL COM-
PLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-1896

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Southern Union Production Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on October 10, 1969, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla "K" Well No. 10 located in Unit D of Section 1, Township 25 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

NOW, on this 30th day of October, 1969, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Southern Union Production Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla "K" Well No. 10 located in Unit D of Section 1, Township 25 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

Under the provisions of Rule 113-A, Southern Union Production

"K" well No. 10 located in Unit 1 of Section 1, Township
35 North, Range 5 West, N.M.M., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in
such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blaine-Blaine
oil pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 10th day of October, 1955, the Secretary
Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions
of Rule 113-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been furnished that all
operators of other leases have been duly notified and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting
period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause water
not impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the completion of the proposed dual completion is
feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant hereby, Southern Union Production Company,
be and the same is hereby authorized to drill complete the
"K" well No. 10 located in Unit 1 of Section 1, Township
35 North, Range 5 West, N.M.M., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in
such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blaine-Blaine
oil pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel completions of
each.

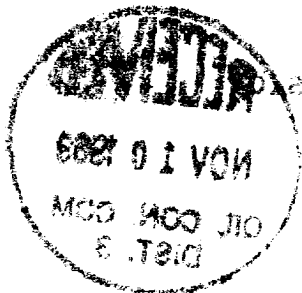
PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall complete, operate, and
