THE APPLICATION OF SOUTHERN UNION  
PRODUCTION COMPANY FOR A DUAL  
COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-1920

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Southern Union Production Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on September 15, 1970, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla "N" Well No. 1 located in Unit K of Section 4, Township 24 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Otero-Gallup Oil Pool and gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

NOW, on this 5th day of October, 1970, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste not impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Southern Union Production Company, is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla "N" Well No. 1 located in Unit K of Section 4, Township 24 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Otero-Gallup Oil Pool and gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

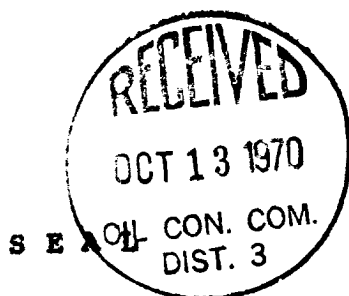
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

Under the provisions of Rule 113-A, Northern Union Production Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on September 12, 1970, for permission to install complete well No. 1 located in Unit X of Section 4, Township 34 North, Range 2 West, Wagon Wheel, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce and deliver oil and gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this day of December, 1970, the Secretary  
Director Linda:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 113-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of oil and gas wells have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed well location will not cause waste or damage to relative rights.
- (5) That the proposed well location is in accordance with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Northern Union Production Company, is hereby authorized to install complete well No. 1 in Unit X of Section 4, Township 34 North, Range 2 West, Wagon Wheel, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce and deliver oil and gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool, in such a manner as to produce and deliver oil and gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That applicant shall comply with the provisions of Rule 113-A.

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
