"Application to Commingle" for your No. 13 Jicarilla 28 well, located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 27, T. 25 N., R. 4 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, on Jicarilla Contract No. 66, has been filed with our District Office at Durango, Colorado. The application provides for the commingling of Gallup and Dakota production within the wellbore. Such commingling has previously been approved by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-4203.

Your application to commingle production in the wellbore of the above-mentioned well is hereby approved, subject to compliance with Order No. R-4203. Approval is also subject to a possible later review by U. S. Geological Survey personnel. This approval automatically terminates if assignments are made such that a communitization agreement for either Gallup or Dakota spacing units become necessary.
