This well was spudded January 10, 1972. Drilled 12 1/4" hole to 228' and ran 7 joints of 8 5/8" OD, 24#, K-55, ST&C casing landed at 227' RB. Surface pipe was cemented to the surface with 150 sacks of Class "A" cement. Good cement returns.

Drilled 7 7/8" hole to 5300' total depth. Ran 151 joints of 5 1/2", 14#, K-55, ST&C casing landed at 5299' RB. Float collar at 5266', stage collar at 3920', cement basket at 3940'. Cemented by BJ. Preceded first stage w/250 gal. mud sweep. Cemented with 180 sacks of 50-50 Poz. "A", 2% gel, 6 1/4# Gilsonite/sack and 1/2 of 1% D-31. Displaced with 33 BW followed by 90 bbl. mud. Bumped plug w/1500 psi at 12:45 p.m. on January 19, 1972. Good returns throughout. Opened stage collar and circulated. Preceded second stage w/250 gal. mud sweep and cemented with 315 sacks 50-50 Poz. "A", 2% gel, 6 1/4# /sack Gilsonite and 1/2 of 1% D-31. Displaced with 98 BW. Bumped plug w/2500 psi at 4:15 p.m. on January 19, 1972. Good returns throughout.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
