Gentlemen:

Application for administrative approval, having been filed in accordance with Commission Order No. R-4203, Continental Oil Company is hereby authorized to drill and complete the following five wells in the manner set forth in said Order No. R-4203:

Jicarilla 22 Well No. 6 NE NE Sec. 22, T-25-N, R-4-W Jicarilla 22 Well No. 7 NE NE Sec. 21, T-25-N, R-4-W Jicarilla 20 Well No. 5 SE SE Sec. 20, T-25-N, R-4-W Jicarilla 30 Well No. 5 NW NE Sec. 32, T-25-N, R-4-W Jicarilla 30 Well No. 6 NW SE Sec. 29, T-25-N, R-4-W

Assignment of allowables to the wells and allocation of production from the wells shall be on the basis set forth in paragraph (3) of Commission Order R-4203. Each well is permitted to produce commingled production at a rate not to exceed 50 barrels of oil per day nor 100 barrels of water per day. The maximum amount of gas which may be produced daily from the commingled sones of each well shall be determined by multiplying 2000 by the top unit allowable for the Gallup sone.

The commingling authority granted by this order may be rescinded by the Secretary-Director if, in his opinion, conservation is not being served by such commingling.
