

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on October 13, 1972, for permission to dually complete its Canyon Largo Unit Well No. 178 located in Unit C of Section 14, Township 25 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Otero-Chacra Pool.

Now, on this 19th day of October, 1972, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Canyon Largo Unit Well No. 178 located in Unit C of Section 14, Township 25 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Otero-Chacra Pool through parallel strings of 2 7/8 inch casing cemented in a common well bore.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take segregation tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

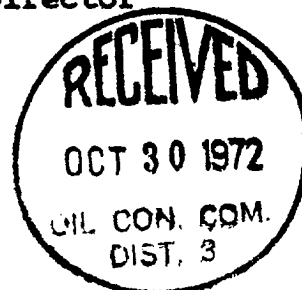
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 113-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take segregation tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That limitation of this cause is hereby referred for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
