

THE APPLICATION OF CHACE OIL COMPANY,
INC. FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-2252

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Chace Oil Company, Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on May 3, 1976, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla 70 Well No. 3 located in Unit C of Section 33, Township 24 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool and production of oil from the South Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool.

Now, on this 10th day of May, 1976, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage;

(3) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Chace Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla 70 Well No. 3 located in Unit C of Section 33, Township 24 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool and production of oil from the South Lindrith Gallup-Dakota Oil Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.


PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

THE APPLICATION OF CERTAIN OIL COMPANIES
FOR A DRILLING PERMIT.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
IN THE OIL AND GAS COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 11-1, Chapter 11, Commission Order No. 1, 1935, for permission to drill a well in the vicinity of Well No. 3 located in Unit 2 of Section 33, Township 14 North, Range 4 West, T14N, R4W, the Artesian County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the fractured oil formation adjacent to the Ballard-Decker Oil Pool and production of oil from the South Indian Artesian Oil Pool.

Now, on this 10th day of May, 1935, the Commission do hereby order:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 11-1 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of oil or gas wells in the vicinity of the proposed well.
- (3) That the proposed well completion will not cause waste nor impair productive capacity.
- (4) That the location of the proposed well completion is feasible and consistent with good conservation practice.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, the Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to drill a well in the vicinity of Well No. 3 located in Unit 2 of Section 33, Township 14 North, Range 4 West, T14N, R4W, the Artesian County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the fractured oil formation adjacent to the Ballard-Decker Oil Pool and production of oil from the South Indian Artesian Oil Pool through the casing tubing annulus and the tubing receptacle.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the applicant shall complete, operate and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 11-1.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that the applicant shall file a back-survey map upon completion of the well.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the completion of this case is hereby referred for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
