

Dear Mr. Hawkins,

Reference is made to your recent request to temporarily downhole commingle the subject pools in the subject well. My staff has reviewed your request on the basis of necessity for testing purposes, and it appears that this request is justified at this time. You are therefore hereby authorized to complete the well in a manner to allow the downhole commingling of the subject pools for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days. At the end of this testing period, the operator shall be required to submit for administrative approval, an application for permanent commingling of production, with all applicable data as specified by Rule 303.C. of the Division Rules and Regulations. If application is not made at the end of the sixty day testing period, the operator shall cease and desist operations to commingle production from the well.

The operator shall further notify the supervisor of the Aztec district office upon implementation of the testing commingling process and at the conclusion to the test period.
