On March 21, 1984, I inspected the Jerome P. McHugh, Native Son #2 well, as a follow up of your call to Mr. Oscar Simpson of our Santa Fe office. As a result of that inspection it was determined that the operator would be required to flare the casing head gas. Mr. Jim Jacobs of Dugan Production had his field people construct a flare line into a pit 10 feet deep. I made a second visit to the referenced well, 23 March 1984, to inspect the flaring operation and found it adequate.

Mrs. Howard, I sincerely hope that this will ease your mind about the gas that is being vented to the atmosphere. If I can be of further assistance, please do not hesitate to contact me.
