Texaco E&P Inc. has been granted verbal approval to construct an earthen reserve pit within the boundary extents of the well's location pad according to the following provisions:

(1) No new surface disturbance, (2) the pit will be doubled lined with a plastic liner, (3) diked walls to prevent spillage, and (4) all drill cuttings and liner material will be removed from the location prior to pit closure.
