4. Spotted 9 gallons of frac sand on top of retainer and left 218 jts. of 2 3/8" tubing in the well circulated in 153 bbl of oil as pickle fluid.
5. NDBOP. NU wellhead and pressure tested casing to 500 psig for 30 minutes. Casing tested.
6. RDMO WSU.

7. Note: on 9/12/01 Bruce Martin with NMOCD witnessed a second test - 600 psig 30 minutes  
The casing passed the test - only 19 psig fall-off (ie less than NMOCD 10%)
