Dear Mr. Stamets:

Union Texas Petroleum (UTP) requests administrative approval for a Basin Dakota Non-Standard Proration Unit comprising the NE/4 (188.01+ acres) of Irregular Section 3-T24N-R5W. In addition, UTP requests administrative approval for an Unorthodox Location for an Otero Gallup completion.

Order R-8106-A, dated December 26, 1986, removed the NW/4, as well as other tracts of Section 3-T24N-R5W, from the Basin Dakota and Otero Gallup Pools and placed the two formations in the West Lindrieth Gallup-Dakota Pool. The well will be completed in both the Gallup and Dakota formations and production will be downhole commingled pursuant to Order R-8109-A. Inasmuch as this well will be drilled in an interior quarter/quarter and UTP operates all adjacent Gallup acreage, there will be no violation or correlative rights.

All offset operators have been notified by certified mail of our request for a Non-Standard Proration Unit. If I may be of any further assistance, please advise.

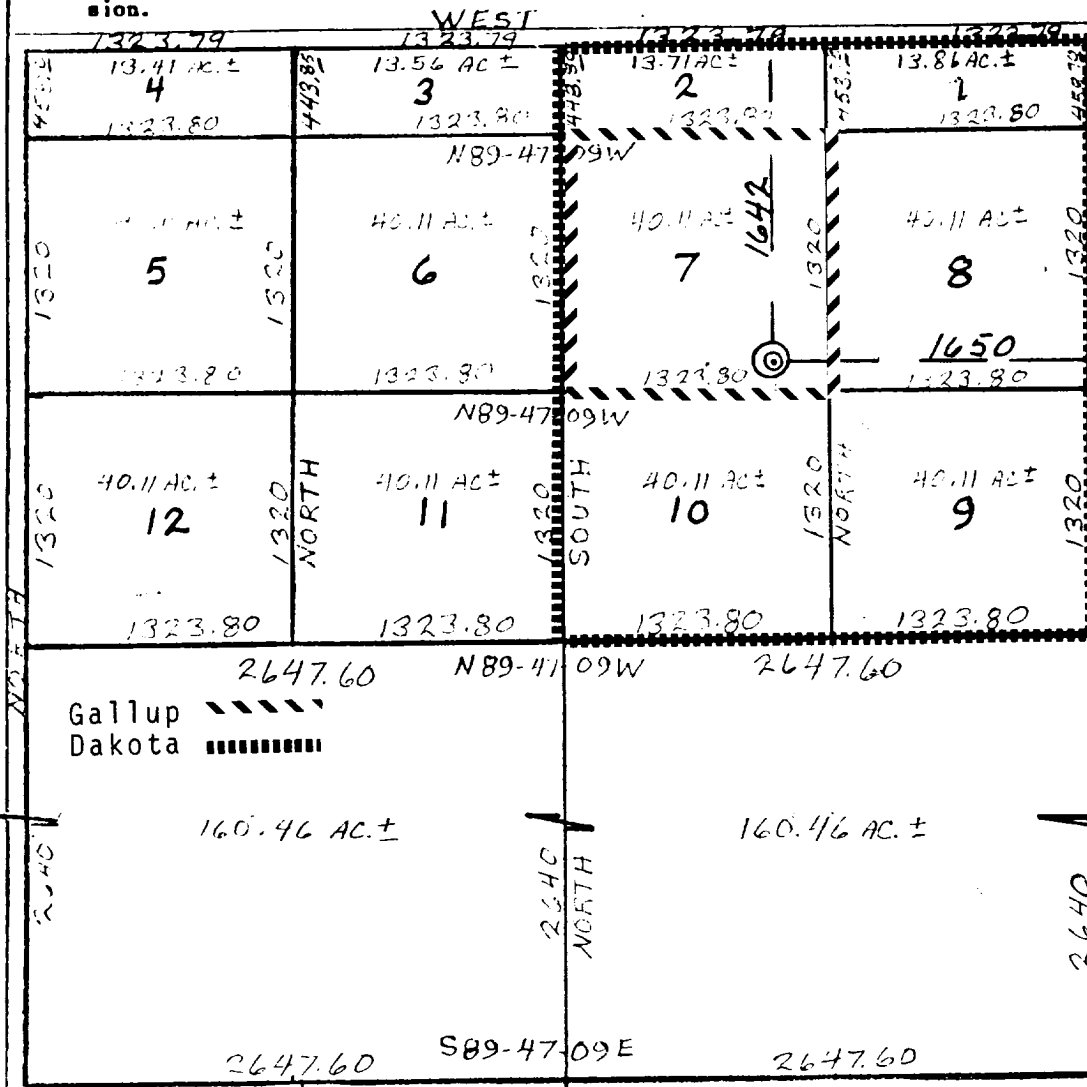

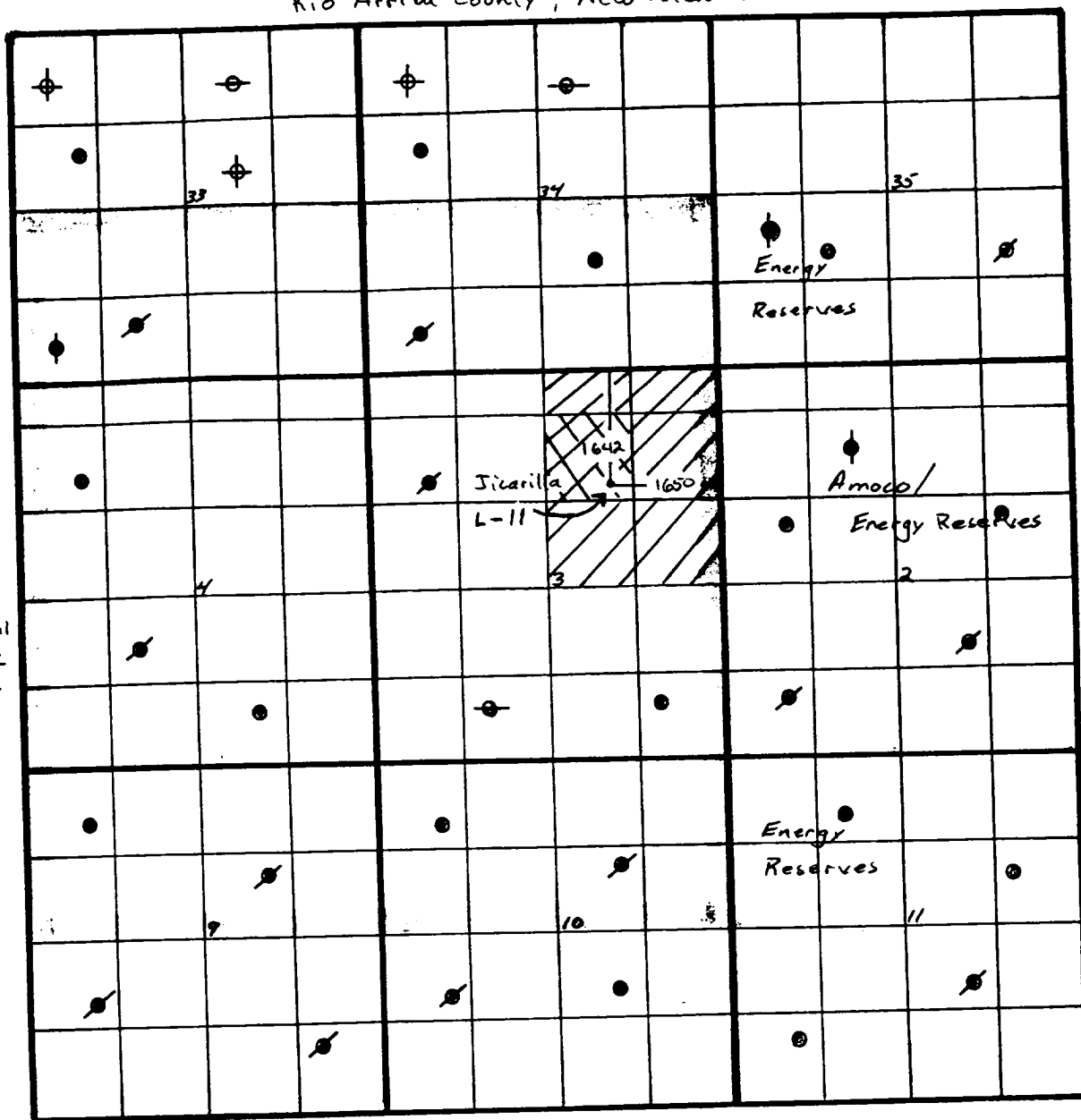

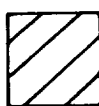
