Dear Jack:

After reviewing your production reports, we have found that the referenced well is overproduced by 17,238 barrels as the end of March. We initially anticipated that you would have a much higher allowable than was assigned on the your excess GOR. allowing the In make-up overproduction, we do not like to exceed six months. Therefore, the amount \mathbf{of} underproduction that will necesssary to compensate for your overproduction should 2500 barrels per month.

You have not yet responded to letters from Sarah Archuleta of our Santa Fe office concerning reporting errors. Your failure to respond to her letters will lead to cancellation of your allowables on the affected wells.

Finally, you are responsible for filing C-111's for the gas that you have been delivering to the pipeline from your own gathering system since March of 1986.
