Dear Mr. Williams:

Reference is made to your application of December 21, 1988 for a non-standard gas well location for your Crane Federal "29" Well No. 7 to be located 2080 feet from the North line and 2150 feet from the East line (Unit G) of Section 29, Township 24 North, Range 1 West, NMPM, Basin-Dakota Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The E/2 of said Section 29 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2 of Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
