Texaco E. & P. Inc. proposes the following to the subject well:
Prior to drilling and testing of the well, a permanent flowline will be installed from the Lydia Rentz #7 to the subject well location. This construction will be in addition to the previously approved (APD) access road and flowline. The #7 well is in the same north 1/2 of Sec. 20 T25N/R3W as the subject well. The Pipeline will go from the wellsite, along the access road to the existing gathering system. This flowline and access road stays within the confines of lease N°SF-079601. Archaeological clearance has been recommended. Placement and construction design of the flowline and access road concurs with surface owner. Construction of the flowline will be as follows:

- Materials will be a wrapped 3" schedule 40, grade B steel line pipe. Connections will be welded.
- Pressure test flowline to 600 psi for 30 minutes. Anticipated working pressure will be approx. 150 psi.
- Length of pipeline will be approx. 2200'.
- Flowline will be buried a minimum of 42" as per surface use agreement.
- All road crossings will be marked and buried a minimum of 42" under the road surface.



RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO




