8-20-69 Ran tubing to 6475' and pumped in 2,000 gallons acid. Displaced acid with 20 barrels oil. Pulled tubing.

8-21-69 Sand-oil fraced. Loaded hole and breakdown with 200 barrels.; Sand-oil mixture - 60,000# 20/40 sand followed with 45,000# 10/20 sand mixed with 2,215 barrels oil. Flushed with 300 barrels oil. Average overall injection rate 86 barrels per minute. No apparent breakdown pressure. Average treating pressure 2400#, minimum 2300#, maximum 2800#. Inst. SDP 1500#. 1-min. SIP 1000#. 5-min. SIP 600#.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
