This sundry notice amends sundry notice dated April 29, 1991 and approved by Bureau of Land Management May 10, 1991.

Operator proposes to use circulating fluid consisting of crude oil (produced from Canada Ojitos Unit wells) with natural gas (produced from COU wells) dissolved in the oil for recompletion drilling.

Operator expects to recover crude oil used in this program however the natural gas will be separated from oil on the surface and flared (same as drilling with natural gas as circulating fluid).
